New investment expert joins OPERS Board of Trustees

COLUMBUS, Ohio – The Ohio Treasurer of State has appointed Scott Richter as its investment expert on the OPERS Board of Trustees.

Richter replaces Richard R. Hollington, Jr., who served in that role from Feb. 2021 until June 2022. Richter is a senior investment portfolio manager at Westfield Group in Westfield Center, Ohio. His term on the Board runs through the end of 2024.

The OPERS Board consists of 11 members. It includes seven elected trustees, the director of the Ohio Department of Administrative Services and three government-appointed investment experts.
