Step 1: Getting Started

Select the policyholder or dependent whose treatment you would like to estimate. Only the policyholder and dependents currently covered under the policy will appear. The selected individual's name will appear under *Your Selections* to the right. Click *Next* to review and accept the terms and conditions to continue.

Select the treatment you would like to estimate. Treatments can be sorted by type of service, affected body part or alphabetically. After selecting a treatment, it will appear under *Your Selections* to the right. Click *Next* to continue.

Step 3: Select Provider(s)

Search for providers by name, location and more. After entering your search criteria, click *Search* and browse the list of matching providers. To select a provider, click the check box to the right of the provider listing. You can choose up to four providers and evaluate their costs using a side-by-side comparison. You can also view the costs of visiting a nonnetwork provider. After selecting a provider, click *Get Costs* to submit your estimate. Your results will appear in a few seconds. Be sure to read the *Did You Know...* section, which highlights ways you can save money on your medical costs.

Step 4: View Estimate

View your results. The results page summarizes the estimate, including the date it was created, patient name, specific treatment and the treatment's procedure code. Your provider may reference this procedure code if you print your estimate and share it with him or her.

Step 4: Estimate Details

The results page also displays the provider name, specialties and a summary of your estimated costs. By clicking *View Estimate Details*, you can view a specific breakdown of your estimated costs. Print this page by clicking *Print Estimate* to the right or select *Start a New Estimate* to refresh your search.
